BOB BRADLEY

HEAD COACH



Bob Bradley was named as Toronto FC's head coach and sporting director on November 24, 2021. Bradley, 63, a three-time MLS Coach of the Year, became the 12th head coach in TFC history and brings over 20 years of head coaching experience to Toronto.

In MLS, Bradley was the first head coach in Chicago Fire history and led the expansion team to the 1998 MLS Cup Championship and U.S. Open Cup Double while earning his first MLS Coach of the Year award. The Fire also played in the 2000 MLS Cup final, where they were defeated 1-0 by Kansas City. Bradley served as the head coach for the New York/New Jersey Metrostars (now New York Red Bulls) from 2003-2005 and Chivas USA in 2006, where he was named the MLS Coach of the Year for elevating the second-year team into the playoffs for the first time.

In the international game, Bradley had a 43-25-12 record as the head coach of the U.S. National Team from 2006-2011 and a record of 22-8-6 as the head coach of Egypt from 2011-2013. The New Jersey native led the U.S. to the 2007 CONCACAF Gold Cup title and qualified the US for the 2010 FIFA World Cup, where they won their group ahead of England, Slovenia and Algeria, before bowing out in the Round of 16 to Ghana. Bradley also led the US to the final of the 2009 FIFA Confederations Cup in South Africa, where they were defeated 3-2 by Brazil. It remains the only appearance by the US men's team in a FIFA sanctioned final. As the coach of Egypt, Bradley's Pharaohs had a perfect 6-0-0 record in the first stage of African World Cup qualifying for Brazil 2014 but were ultimately eliminated by Ghana in a two-game aggregate.

Bradley's club coaching resume also includes three stops in Europe, having coached Stabæk in Norway's Eliteserien (2014-15), Le Havre in France's Ligue 2 (2015-16), and Swansea City of the English Premier League (2016), where he became the first American to manage a Premier League club.

Named as the first coach in LAFC history in July of 2017, Bradley led the club to 57 points in 2018, the most points ever recorded by a first-year club in league history. In 2019, LAFC set what was then a league record with 72 points in the regular season. The 2019 edition of LAFC led MLS with 85 goals while also allowing the fewest goals (37) of any team in the league. The +48-goal differential was 27 goals better than any other team in the league. Bradley earned his third MLS Coach of the Year award following the record-breaking regular season and capturing the MLS Supporters' Shield in 2019. In 2020, LAFC advanced to the final of the Scotiabank Concacaf Champions League, knocking off three of Mexico's most famous teams (León, Cruz Azul, and Club América) before losing 2-1 to Tigres UANL in the final.

Bradley joins TFC with the third-most regular season wins (182) in league history and has led teams to an MLS Cup (1998 Chicago Fire), an MLS Supporters' Shield (2019 Los Angeles FC) and two US Open Cup (1998 and 2000 Chicago Fire) titles during his years in Major League Soccer.

COACHING STAFF

MIKE SORBER – ASSISTANT COACH & TECHNICAL DIRECTOR




Mike Sorber joined TFC after spending the past four seasons as assistant coach with Los Angeles FC (2018-2021). Prior to LAFC, Sorber had assistant coaching stints with the Philadelphia Union (2014-2017) and Montreal Impact (2011-2013). Sorber previously worked with Bradley as an assistant with the U.S. Men's National Team (2007-2011).

Sorber also served as an assistant coach with his alma mater, Saint Louis University (2001-2007). As a player, Sorber made 67 appearances for the U.S. Men's National Team and played in all four of the USMNT's matches at the 1994 FIFA World Cup. He became the first American to be named a Mexican League All-Star with UNAM Pumas in 1995 before spending time in MLS with the Kansas City Wizards, MetroStars and Chicago Fire.

Sorber was inducted into the St. Louis Soccer Hall of Fame in October 2017.

PAUL STALTERI – ASSISTANT COACH



Paul Stalteri, a long-time Canadian national team player, spent the last two seasons as assistant coach of Canadian Premier League (CPL) side, York United FC, helping the team make the playoffs for the first time in franchise history in 2021.

As a player, Stalteri made 84 appearances for the Canadian Men's National Team between 1997 and 2010. With Canada, he won the 2000 Concacaf Gold Cup, was twice named Canadian Player of the Year (2001 and 2004), was named to the All-Tournament Team at the 2007 Concacaf Gold Cup and captained Canada in 30 matches from 2007 to 2010. At the club level, Stalteri began his career with Toronto Lynx before spending majority of his playing career in Europe, representing Werder Bremen, Tottenham Hotspur, Fulham and Borussia Mönchengladbach between 1998 and 2011.

Stalteri was inducted into the Canada Soccer Hall of Fame in September 2017.

JON CONWAY – GOALKEEPER COACH



Jon Conway enters his ninth season as goalkeeper coach for Toronto FC. He originally joined the first team on August 31, 2014 after spending the previous two seasons as goalkeeper head coach with the Toronto FC Academy. Conway was part of the club's Treble winning side in 2017 (MLS Cup, Supporters' Shield, Canadian Championship) and an additional two Canadian Championship winning sides (2016, 2018).

Prior to the start of his coaching career, Conway had a successful career as a goalkeeper in Major League Soccer that began with the San Jose Earthquakes in 2000. In five seasons with the Earthquakes, Conway was part of two MLS Cup Championship teams. Conway was traded to the New York MetroStars who eventually became the Red Bulls and remained with the club for four seasons. He later joined Chivas USA (2009), Toronto FC (2010) where he won one Canadian Championship with the Reds and finally with the Chicago Fire (2011). Conway retired as a player at the conclusion of the 2011 season.

Conway holds a USSF "B" Licence and an NSCAA Goalkeeping Level II Coaching Certification.






