



## Return to Play Participant Agreement

This Return to Play Participant Agreement (the "**Agreement**") was developed by Vancouver Whitecaps FC LP (the "**Club**") pursuant to, and in accordance with, guidelines and recommendations provided by public health authorities, the British Columbia Soccer Association, the Canada Soccer Association, and ViaSport British Columbia.

For the purposes of this Agreement, "**Activities**" mean any soccer activities organized, offered, or sanctioned by the Club or any other soccer associations affiliated with the Club; and "**Participants**" include Club representatives, coaches, athletes, parents or guardians of athletes, or any other individuals who participate in the Activities or attend to any facilities and/or locations where the Activities are being held.

Please read the information below carefully prior to confirming your understanding and acknowledgment of the Club's Return to Play protocols and policies in the registration process for any Activities. It is required that all participants understand and acknowledge their role in adhering to the Club's commitment to ensuring a safe environment during the Activities.

As a Participant, and a parent or guardian of a player Participant (the "**Player**"), I understand and/or agree to the following:

- I have reviewed and understand the Club's Return to Play protocols outlined above on <https://www.whitecapsfc.com/safesport/safe-sport-return-play-guidelines>
- The Player will be subject to symptom screening checks prior to the Player participating in any Activities and the Player is required to inform the Club if he/she has experienced any symptoms of contagious illness including COVID-19 symptoms such as fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat and painful swallowing, stuffy or runny nose, loss of sense of smell, nausea and vomiting, headache, diarrhea, muscle aches, fatigue and loss of appetite (collectively, "**Symptoms**") in the 14 days leading up to him/her participating in any Activities;
- Participants are required to continue to follow all protocols and directives of applicable provincial and federal health authorities, including, but not limited to, protocols related to social distancing and self isolation following travel;



- The player is required to inform his/her coach or another representative of the Club immediately if, while participating in the Activities, the Player experiences any Symptoms;
- The Player is not permitted to participate in any Activities if he/she has experience any Symptoms until the Player has experienced no such Symptoms for 14 consecutive days and/or obtained clearance from a healthcare professional;
- If the Player has come in to contact with someone who has displayed any Symptoms, or tested positive for COVID-19, I am required to inform a coach or representative of the Club and the Player is required to obtain clearance from a healthcare professional prior to returning to any Activities;
- Participants that are permitted to access facilities in which Activities are taking place are required to sanitize their hands, with soap and sanitizer, upon entering and exiting such facilities;
- I am expected to participate in the online welcome meetings organized by the Club prior to the first day of any Activities that the Player is registered for;
- Participants shall receive drop-off/pick-up instructions and procedures prior to the first day of any Activities and are required to abide by such instructions and procedures at any locations and/or facilities where Activities are taking place;
- If I or the Player do not abide by any of the policies/guidelines outlined in this Agreement and the Club's Return to Play protocols outlined above, the Player may be asked to leave the Club and/or refrain from participating in any Activities for up to 14 consecutive days and/or until the Player has obtained clearance from a healthcare professional;
- Continued abuse of any of the policies/guidelines outlined in this Agreement and the Club's Return to Play protocols outlined above may result in the Player's temporary or permanent suspension from any Activities;
- There are risks associated with participating in the Activities and/or entering any locations and/or facilities where the Activities are taking place, and that measures taken by the Club and Participants, including those outlined in this



Agreement and the Club's Return to Play protocols outlined above, will not entirely eliminate these risks;

- If the Player displays any Symptoms within 14 days after attending any Activities, it is my responsibility to inform the Club; and
- If the Player displays any Symptoms, the Club may inform other Participants in accordance with public health guidelines, while exercising its best efforts to ensure the privacy and confidentiality of the Player.
