MATCH PREVIEW

Real Monarchs travel to San Diego, California to take on Loyal SC at Torero Stadium on Saturday, August 7. Kickoff is set for 8:30 p.m. MT and can be streamed live on ESPN+.

Records: Real Monarchs (3-10-4, 13 points); San Diego Loyal SC (7-6-3, 24 points)

Head-to-Head: San Diego Loyal SC holds the advantage over Real Monarchs with an all-time record of 1-0-0, with the lone match being played last season in San Diego's inaugural campaign. Loyal SC owns a plus one goal differential in the matchup overall. The previous match between the sides ended in a 1-0 defeat for the Monarchs at Rio Tinto Stadium on July 11, 2020.

Connections: San Diego Loyal SC midfielder Jack Blake played 59 matches for the Real Monarchs from 2018-2020. The former captain of the Monarchs recorded 13 goals and five assists for the club, including three goals and one assist in the 2019 USL Championship Playoffs to help the club win its first USL Championship Title.

Notes: In just the second all-time meeting between the sides, the Monarchs will look to even up the series against San Diego on the road. Real Monarchs are 26-47-17 all-time on the road, while San Diego Loyal SC is 7-5-3 all-time at home.

LAST TIME VS OPPONENT

Real Monarchs fell 1-0 to San Diego Loyal SC in the USL Championship's return to play on Saturday in the club's first match since March 7. A first half goal from Grant Stoneman was enough to give San Diego the full three points as both sides re-opened USL Championship play.

Both teams started the match with big chances as the sides felt out the game in the early stages. After the Monarchs failed to capitalize on two chances in the first six minutes, goalkeeper Jimmy Slayton was immediately forced into a fantastic save to keep San Diego Loyal SC off the scoresheet and keep the sides level. Now on the front foot, Loyal SC had another shot on goal deflected away by Monarchs defender Andrew Brody before seeing their early push break the tie in the 17th minute. After winning a corner, Loyal SC midfielder Jack Metcalf whipped a corner into the box and found the head of Grant Stoneman for the 1-0 lead.

Following a mandatory water break in the 30th minute, the Monarchs saw their best chance of the half as a cross from midfielder Jack Blake found forward Kyle Coffee, but his shot hit the bottom of the bar and bounce behind the goal line but no goal was awarded.

The Monarchs thought it had brought the match level when in the 86th minute, Ryan Sierakowski's headed effort looked destined to cross the goal line once more, but a clearance from Loyal SC kept the home side off the score sheet as the match ended 1-0.

LAST MATCH RECAP

Real Monarchs (3-10-4, 13 points) fell 3-0 to Rio Grande Valley FC at Zions Bank Stadium. Goals from Edvin Quero, John Sanchez and Christian Sorto earned Rio Grande Valley FC the full three points.

The Monarchs started the first half on the front foot, applying constant pressure in the away side's half of the pitch. After several stops by the Toros defense, Rio Grande Valley FC settled the match and found the breakthrough in the 19th minute.

Rio Grande Valley doubled the lead in the 54th minute on a shot inside the box from Sanchez. In the 77th minute, Ibrahim Bancé received his second yellow, forcing the Monarchs down to 10-men the rest of the way. Six minutes later, the Toros scored their third goal on a close shot from Sorto and the match ended in favor of Rio Grande Valley.

SEASON STORYLINES

Youngest Signings in Club History

The Real Monarchs will be featuring two of the youngest signings in club history in its seventh season1. In January, Real Salt Lake signed RSL Academy product and Herriman City native Jeff Dewsnup. At 16-years-old the goalkeeper became the youngest signing in RSL history and the first-ever Herriman City native to sign for the club. The Monarchs then made 15-year-old Julio Benitez its youngest-ever signing when he signed with the team in march. The midfielder was also an RSL Academy stand-out.

Welcome in the Kiwis

In back-to-back months during the offseason the Monarchs signed the team's first-ever players from New Zealand. The first was 20-year-old forward Max Mata who arrived from Switzerland where he spent time with the second tier of Grasshopper, scoring five goals in 10 matches. The second was 24-year-old Kyle Adams from the Houston Dynamo FC where he appeared in 61 matches for Houston's USL Championship affiliate, Rio Grande Valley FC.

Columbian Trio

As the Monarchs continued to revamp its roster this offseason, the team signed three young players from Columbia. 21-yearold defender Kevin Saucedo signed with the Monarchs after spending the 2020 season with Colombian Categoria Primera A side Millonarios F.C. He represented Columbia in the 2019 FIFA U-20 World Cup. In January, the Monarchs signed its second Columbian of the offseason in Brayan Gomez. The 21-year-old midfielder played for CDC Atletico Nacional at the U-20 level in Columbia. Internationally, Gomez represented Columbia in the 2017 FIFA U-17 World Cup alongside his Real Monarchs teammate Juan Vidal. 20-year-old Vidal is the third Columbian on the roster this season who joins the club from CF Barranquilla.

Real Monarchs 2.0

2021 marks the beginning of the Real Monarchs 2.0, a new blueprint set by the front office to optimize the roster and promote opportunity and growth within the club. The Monarchs are shifting focus to signing promising young internationals and promoting heavily from the RSL Academy. With eight new international signings joining James Moberg, Sam Brown and Jimmy Slayton, there are now a lot of roster spots available for Academy products to see the pitch and make an impact. Headlined by Benitez, Academy youngsters are expected to make up almost a third of the roster this season.
