MATCH PREVIEW

Real Monarchs travel to El Paso Locomotive FC on Wednesday, September 29 at Southwest University Park in the final match between the two sides this season. Kickoff is set for 7:00 p.m. MT and can be streamed live on ESPN+.

Records: Real Monarchs (4-16-5, 17 points); El Paso Locomotive FC (13-2-8, 47 points)

Head-to-Head: El Paso Locomotive have the advantage over Real Monarchs with an all-time record of 8-0-2 in ten matches played. The previous match between the sides ended in a 3-1 defeat for the Monarchs at Southwest University Park on July 31, 2021 with Charlie Wehan scoring the lone goal for the visitors.

Connections: El Paso midfielder Sebastian Velasquez previously played for Real Salt Lake from 2012-14, appearing in 43 matches, and for Real Monarchs from 2017-18 during which he logged 49 appearances and helped lift the 2017 regular-season trophy.

Notes: The Monarchs will look to build on this past weekend's result and earn its first-ever win against a division-leading El Paso side that is undefeated at home so far this season. Real Monarchs are 27-51-17 all-time on the road, while Locomotive FC is 24-5-9 all-time as hosts.

LAST MATCH RECAP

Real Monarchs (4-16-5, 17 points) played to a 0-0 draw against Eastern Conference opponent New York Red Bulls II at Zions Bank Stadium in the first-ever meeting between the two clubs.

The first half hour of the match was played evenly with the two sides sharing equal possession. The Monarchs came close to scoring in the 34th minute when midfielder Malik Johnson spun past three defenders before threading a through ball to forward Charlie Wehan inside the box, but Wehan's shot was pushed out for a corner. In the 42nd minute, Wehan beat the defense once again, but his shot aimed at the top right corner was parried out to keep the home side off the scoreboard. Two minutes later, New York Red Bulls II were awarded a penalty for a hand ball in the box, but the ensuing penalty kick was saved by goalkeeper Jimmy Slayton and the sides entered the break scoreless.

The Monarchs began the second half on front foot, flying down the right side of the pitch on two consecutive occasions, Bode Davis crossed the ball in towards Aris Briggs, but Briggs was unable to finish either chance. In the 78th minute, Red Bulls II earned a free kick from just outside the 18-yard box, but Mandela Egbo's kick was deflected out for a corner by Slayton in a diving effort. Johnson was shown a second yellow in the 90th minute and was subsequently dismissed from the match, leaving the home side with ten men. Despite going down a man, the Monarchs held strong in added time and the match ended 0-0.

LAST TIME VS OPPONENT

Real Monarchs (3-9-4, 13 points) fell 3-1 to El Paso Locomotive FC at Southwest University Park. Charlie Wehan scored his second professional goal in as many matches.

The Monarchs applied attacking pressure from the starting whistle, which paid off in the 17th minute when Aris Briggs passed the ball inside the box to Wehan, who buried his shot into the back of the net to open the scoring. Seven minutes later, El Paso equalized on a shot from Gomez that took a deflection on its way into goal. The sides remained level for the rest of the half and entered the break 1-1.

As a 58th minute substitute, Solignac received a cross into the box and cleaned up a spill from the goalkeeper to give El Paso the lead. In the 81st minute, Solignac logged his brace to extend the Locos lead and the match ended 3-1 in favor of El Paso.

SEASON STORYLINES

Youngest Signings in Club History

The Real Monarchs will be featuring two of the youngest signings in club history in its seventh season. In January, Real Salt Lake signed RSL Academy product and Herriman City native Jeff Dewsnap. At 16-years-old the goalkeeper became the youngest signing in RSL history and the first-ever Herriman City native to sign for the club. The Monarchs then made 15-year-old Julio Benitez its youngest-ever signing when he signed with the team in March. The midfielder was also an RSL Academy stand-out.

Welcome in the Kiwis

In back-to-back months during the offseason the Monarchs signed the team's first-ever players from New Zealand. The first was 20-year-old forward Max Mata who arrived from Switzerland where he spent time with the second tier of Grasshopper, scoring five goals in 10 matches. The second was 24-year-old Kyle Adams from the Houston Dynamo FC where he appeared in 61 matches for Houston's USL Championship affiliate, Rio Grande Valley FC.

Columbian Trio

As the Monarchs continued to revamp its roster this offseason, the team signed three young players from Columbia. 21-year-old defender Kevin Saucedo signed with the Monarchs after

spending the 2020 season with Colombian Categoria Primera A side Millonarios F.C. He represented Columbia in the 2019 FIFA U-20 World Cup. In January, the Monarchs signed its second Columbian of the offseason in Brayan Gomez. The 21-year-old midfielder played for CDC Atletico Nacional at the U-20 level in Columbia. Internationally, Gomez represented Columbia in the 2017 FIFA U-17 World Cup alongside his Real Monarchs teammate Juan Vidal. 20-year-old Vidal is the third Columbian on the roster this season who joins the club from CF Barranquilla.

Real Monarchs 2.0

2021 marks the beginning of the Real Monarchs 2.0, a new blueprint set by the front office to optimize the roster and promote opportunity and growth within the club. The Monarchs are shifting focus to signing promising young internationals and promoting heavily from the RSL Academy. With eight new international signings joining James Moberg, Sam Brown and Jimmy Slayton, there are now a lot of roster spots available for Academy products to see the pitch and make an impact. Headlined by Benitez, Academy youngsters are expected to make up almost a third of the roster this season.

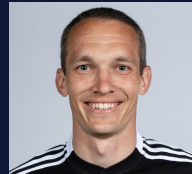

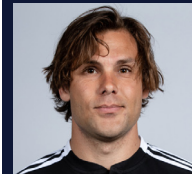

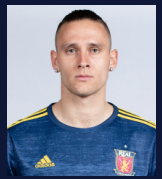
