MATCH PREVIEW

Real Monarchs travel to Albuquerque to face New Mexico United at Isotopes Park in the 2021 USL Championship Regular-Season finale on Saturday, October 30, while seeking to earn the Club's first-ever win in New Mexico. Kickoff is set for 5:00 p.m. MT and can be streamed live on ESPN+.

Records: Real Monarchs (5-19-7, 22 points); New Mexico United (11-10-10, 43 points)

Head-to-Head: New Mexico United has the advantage over Real Monarchs with an all-time record of 7-2-0 in 9 matches played, including a 2-0-0 record at Isotopes Park. The previous match between the sides resulted in a 2-1 defeat for the Monarchs at Isotopes Park on September 18.

Connections: New Mexico United defender Kalen Ryden spent two seasons with Real Monarchs from 2018-2019, recording nine goals and three assists in 67 appearances. His last goal for the Monarchs was the equalizer in the 48th minute of the Western Conference Semifinals, helping the club on its way to the USL Championship Title in 2019.

Notes: In what will be the 10th all-time regular-season meeting with New Mexico, the Real Monarchs will look to throw a wrench in United's postseason plans. Real Monarchs are 27-53-17 all-time on the road, while New Mexico United is 13-5-14 all-time as hosts.

LAST TIME VS OPPONENT

Real Monarchs (4-16-4, 16 points) fell 2-1 to Mountain Division rivals New Mexico United at Isotopes Park.

New Mexico United got things going in the 15th minute of the match on a free kick by midfielder Chris Wehan that was headed back by Monarchs defender Jaziel Orozco, but Orozco's header came short of clearing the box and the ensuing header by defender Kalen Ryden lasered on frame before being quickly pushed over the top by goalkeeper Jeff Dewsnup to keep the hosts off the board and both sides entered the break scoreless after a tightly-contested first half.

The hosts found the breakthrough three minutes into the second half with a right-footed blast by Amando Moreno that beat the goalkeeper into the top-left corner of the net for the 1-0 lead, but it only took the Monarchs two minutes to equalize. In the 50th minute, the Monarchs poached a throw-in and found Charlie Wehan open in space above the box. Wehan passed three defenders before beating the goalkeeper with a shot into the left side of the net to bring the score to 1-1. The hosts jumped back on top for good in the 80th minute with a header from New Mexico's Wehan and the match ended 2-1 in favor of New Mexico.

LAST MATCH RECAP

Real Monarchs (5-19-7, 22 points) fell 3-1 to Rio Grande Valley FC Toros in the home finale at Zions Bank Stadium.

The visitors found the back of the net early in the first half after an unfortunate deflection off of a Monarchs defender left forward Christian Sorto one-on-one with the goalkeeper inside the box to give the Toros the 1-0 lead in the 16th minute. The home side found the equalizer in the 41st minute when a collision at the top of the box resulted in the ball being deflected off of Toros defender Adrian Diz Pe and into the back of the net to bring the score to 1-1 at the halftime break.

The Toros struck first again to start the second half when Fjeldberg received the ball on the edge of the box from Sorto. After beating a defender on the left side, Fjeldberg fired a right-footed curler into the top-right corner of the net to retake the lead for the visitors and bring the score to 2-1 in the 62nd minute. Four minutes later, the Toros extended its lead with a free-kick goal into the top-right corner by Rodrigo Lopez, bringing the match to its final scoreline of 3-1.

SEASON STORYLINES

Youngest Signings in Club History

The Real Monarchs will be featuring two of the youngest signings in club history in its seventh season1. In January, Real Salt Lake signed RSL Academy product and Herriman City native Jeff Dewsnup. At 16-years-old the goalkeeper became the youngest signing in RSL history and the first-ever Herriman City native to sign for the club. The Monarchs then made 15-year-old Julio Benitez its youngest-ever signing when he signed with the team in march. The midfielder was also an RSL Academy stand-out.

Welcome in the Kiwis

In back-to-back months during the offseason the Monarchs signed the team's first-ever players from New Zealand. The first was 20-year-old forward Max Mata who arrived from Switzerland where he spent time with the second tier of Grasshopper, scoring five goals in 10 matches. The second was 24-year-old Kyle Adams from the Houston Dynamo FC where he appeared in 61 matches for Houston's USL Championship affiliate, Rio Grande Valley FC.

Columbian Trio

As the Monarchs continued to revamp its roster this offseason, the team signed three young players from Columbia. 21-year-old defender Kevin Saucedo signed with the Monarchs after

spending the 2020 season with Colombian Categoria Primera A side Millonarios F.C. He represented Columbia in the 2019 FIFA U-20 World Cup. In January, the Monarchs signed its second Columbian of the offseason in Brayan Gomez. The 21-year-old midfielder played for CDC Atletico Nacional at the U-20 level in Columbia. Internationally, Gomez represented Columbia in the 2017 FIFA U-17 World Cup alongside his Real Monarchs teammate Juan Vidal. 20-year-old Vidal is the third Columbian on the roster this season who joins the club from CF Barranquilla.

Real Monarchs 2.0

2021 marks the beginning of the Real Monarchs 2.0, a new blueprint set by the front office to optimize the roster and promote opportunity and growth within the club. The Monarchs are shifting focus to signing promising young internationals and promoting heavily from the RSL Academy. With eight new international signings joining James Moberg, Sam Brown and Jimmy Slayton, there are now a lot of roster spots available for Academy products to see the pitch and make an impact. Headlined by Benitez, Academy youngsters are expected to make up almost a third of the roster this season.
