

615 CHALLENGE PRESENTED BY BODYARMOR RULES

OBJECTIVE: Participants, either individuals or teams of up to five (5) persons, are invited to enter the 615 Challenge; a contest that challenges participants (either as an individual assigned to a team or as a team) to run, walk, or jog 615 miles between July 1, 2022 and July 30, 2022. Each participant (individual or team) must report their mileage on a weekly basis. Each individual (assigned to a team) or team that completes 615 miles will win a prize and the individual (assigned to a team) or team that completes the most miles will win the Grand Prize. Grand prize is as follows: (1) Player Appearance, (2) tickets per winner, (1) Signed jersey per winner, (1) Case of 16oz product per winner.

ENTRY/ CONTEST PERIOD: Participants and teams can sign up for the challenge starting June 15 by filling out the form below. The official contest will start on Friday, July 1, and it will conclude on Saturday, July 30. Once participants have signed up, Nashville SC will track the teams and mileage on excel files. Prizes will be announced at a later date.

ELIGIBILITY: The 615 Challenge Contest (“Contest”) is open to legal residents who live within a seventy-five (75) mile radius from Nashville, Tennessee (the “Territory”) who are of legal age of majority in the jurisdiction in which they reside (and at least 18 years old) at the time of entry. Employees, officers, and directors (including immediate family members (spouse, parent, child and sibling and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside) and members of the same household, whether or not related) of Nashville Team Holdings LLC (the “Club” or “Sponsor”), BodyArmor (“Partner”), Major League Soccer, L.L.C. (“MLS”), and Soccer United Marketing, LLC (“SUM” and collectively with Sponsor and MLS, the “MLS Entities”) and each of their respective parents, affiliated companies, subsidiaries, licensees, distributors, dealers, retailers, printers and advertising and promotion agencies, and any and all other companies associated with the Contest are not eligible to participate or win a prize.
