

Second Annual Nashville SC Riff Off Competition

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY AND NO ENTRY FEE TO ENTER OR WIN.

Official Rules

OBJECTIVE: Participants are invited to enter themselves into the Second Annual Nashville SC Riff Off Competition. Between September 9, 2022 and September 14, 2022 (the “Entry Period”). During the Entry Period, participants will submit a 30-second video of them performing an original guitar riff. From the pool of participants, Nashville Soccer Club will select 8 finalists in their sole and absolute discretion to be announced on September 16, 2022. The 8 chosen finalists will compete in-person in head-to-head matchups at the Riff Off Event on September 24, 2022. Winners of each head-to-head matchup will be chosen by judges in their sole and absolute discretion. The competition will proceed until a champion is crowned.

ENTRY/ CONTEST PERIOD: Participants can submit an entry during the Entry Period by filling out the form here (www.nashvillefc.com/riffoff). All entries not submitted during the Entry Period will be invalid and will void such entries. The 8 finalists will be announced September 16, 2022. The 8 finalists will compete in-person on September 24, 2022 and the winner will be chosen and announced during the event. The winner will perform the Guitar Riff at the 10/2 home match and receive a customized Nashville SC replica homecoming jersey, Gibson Epiphone guitar, two tickets for 10/2 home match, trophy and guitar picks. Total ARV is \$2,364. The runner-up will receive a customized Nashville SC replica homecoming jersey, two (2) tickets to the 10/2 home match, trophy and guitar picks. Total ARV is \$364. The 6 other finalists will receive a trophy and guitar picks. Total ARV is \$840.

ELIGIBILITY: The Riff Off (“Contest”) is open to legal residents who live within a seventy-five (75) mile radius from Nashville, Tennessee (the “Territory”). No videos can include anybody under the age of eighteen (18) years old, and any video submitted with an individual under the age of eighteen (18) will be automatically disqualified. Employees, officers, and directors (including immediate family members (spouse, parent, child and sibling and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside) and members of the same household, whether or not related) of Nashville Soccer Club LLC (the “Club” or “Sponsor”), Walsh Management LLC (“Walsh”), Major League Soccer, L.L.C. (“MLS”) and its member teams, and Soccer United Marketing, LLC (“SUM” and collectively with Sponsor, Walsh, and MLS, the “MLS Entities”) and each of their respective parents, affiliated companies, subsidiaries, licensees, distributors, dealers, retailers, sponsors, printers and advertising and promotion agencies, and any and all other companies associated with the Contest are not eligible to participate or win a prize. The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws, rules and regulations. Void outside Territory, and where prohibited or restricted by law, rule or regulation.

Waiver

NASHVILLE SC EVENT and PHOTOGRAPH RELEASE

For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, and in connection with my admission to, and/or voluntary participation in, the Second Annual Nashville SC Riff Off Competition,

1. acknowledge and accept sole responsibility for all of the hazards and risks to me and my property associated with or related to my participation in the Event and for any damage or injury that I may cause to others;

2. release, waive and forever discharge any and all claims of damages or causes of action, including but not limited to, death, personal injury or loss or damage to property, which I or any of the my representatives, heirs, next of kin or assignees (my "Representatives") may have or which may hereinafter accrue to me or my Representatives as a result of my voluntary participation in the Event or otherwise and which may be asserted by me or my Representatives against the MLS Entities, and each of their respective successors, assignees, licensees and affiliates, any sponsor, promoter or advertiser of the Event, and any of their respective related entities, subsidiaries and affiliates (collectively, "Released Entities"), and for each such Released Entity, its respective officers, directors, owners, governors, officials, volunteers, employees, agents, representatives, successors, and assigns (collectively, and together with the Released Entities, the "Releasees"), whether caused by the acts, omissions or negligence of any Releasee or by any other person or entity;
3. grant permission to the Released Entities (or their respective licensees) to utilize my name, voice, statements, photograph, image, likeness, actions and/or biographical data in any live or recorded form (including, but not limited to, any form of photographic/video display or other transmission or reproduction) (the "Materials"), in whole or in part, for promotional, commercial or any other purpose, in perpetuity worldwide in any media whether now known or hereafter created without any additional consideration (the "Permitted Use");
4. represent and warrant that I have the full right, power and authorization to grant the rights granted hereunder and hereby agrees to indemnify, release and hold harmless each of the Released Entities from and against any and all claims, damages, costs and liabilities of any kind (including outside attorneys' fees and expenses) arising out of or related to the use of the Materials (including, but not limited to, any likeness or other element contained therein);
5. hereby waive any so-called "moral rights" or like rights with respect to the Materials and agree that the Materials may be cut, edited, and otherwise modified as part of the Permitted Use;
6. acknowledge that (a) the Released Entities are relying on the foregoing grant of rights and (b) nothing contained herein shall be deemed to obligate the Released Entities to make any use of the Materials and/or the rights granted herein; and
7. represent that I am eighteen (18) years of age or older, and no one under the age of eighteen (18) is included in the submitted material.
