## **RE: Overall thoughts**

"Yeah, I think we were just on the front foot, we were taking it to them a little bit, to then give up a goal like that, it might've taken the air out a little bit, but I think we needed a minute or two after that, and we had a ton of good chances. I don't think the fans stopped, maybe for the celebration they stopped, but it was loud in there, they kept it up."

RE: You had a big moment, a big save on that one on one against Messi, just like down the line what those moments represent for you as players. If you've given it some thought of what do you do with those jerseys - do you have others in your collection? "Yeah, I have a couple of jerseys.
