**RE: “In your opinion, how important is it to you as a keeper to see everyone contribute to the defending part of the game?”**

“We talk about clean sheets, yes, to be honest I would have preferred to win today than to get clean sheet because the first target when you go on the field is to win. When you are a defender, when you’re a goalkeeper, you are always looking to have an impact and the best way to give to your team a chance to win a game is to not concede a goal. Today we did it - I think we were strong against a really good opponent but at least we managed to not lose it and get a draw. But to make this point important we need to win the next game. To go away in Minnesota will be very difficult so hopefully we are going to get a better day offensively and we will make the right decision at the right time and score goals and enjoy more football.”

**RE: On what he's seen in the team's style of play in the first few games and if things are still a work in progress:**

"Yes, there's still plenty of work to make. Obviously, we cannot be satisfied with the performance today. Even if we managed some situations better, we could have scored, probably. But it's part of the game, you know? Also, you need to give credit to the opponent because it's a really good team. They are developing really good football. Playing short, playing on the floor and respecting the right position. It's a really good team, but I think in transition there was much more to explore. I think in the final third, I don't know, I believe we didn't make the right decisions at some important moments of the game. But still, we managed to get a clean sheet. That's a positive. It's a mixed feeling, because when you go on the field you just want to win. When it doesn't happen, you need to analyze and make yourself better. Obviously, the next game will become very important, because it's going to make the difference between a good start and an average start. We want to stay on the top. We don't want to be in the middle of the table. So, that's why the next game is really important. We have one week to prepare and we need to deliver more."
